

Research on Pornography tells us:

- Porn lies
- Porn can rewire a young man's brain and prevent him from bonding with his future wife
- Porn is very addictive
- Porn desensitizes
- Porn can cause erectile dysfunction
- Porn material is almost always found in a rapist's apartment or car
- Porn kills love
- Porn has become a public health crisis
- Porn is a violation of Federal Obscenity laws
- Mainstream porn is violent and abusive and 11 yr olds have access to it
- Mindgeek controls most of the porn websites, based in Luxembourg
- 36% of internet is porn
- Online porn is making \$3,000 a second
- 1 in 4 search queries is about porn
- Peer Review Studies estimate 90% of scenes in porn have some sort of violence against women or children
- Porn is about making hate to women
- Disrespect, humiliation, debasement, dehumanization, violence
- Porn wipes out any sense of intimacy
- Innocent young boys look up porn on the web and are traumatized by violent images and men saying, "what every man wants to do"
- Porn is also a social justice issue
- Porn is a biologically addictive medium which alters brain reward and motivation systems in a negative way
- Porn causes shrinkage and abnormalities in the brain reward center and the prefrontal lobe
- Addiction hijacks the brain reward center
- Pornography is an act of prostitution
- Porn documents and facilitates sex trafficking

- Porn is prostitution that is legalized as long as you take pictures
- Close to 80% of the time, women in the sex industry are under the control of a pimp. That is trafficking.
- Porn, prostitution, and sex trafficking are pretty much all the same thing from the viewpoint of a woman in the sex trade
- Porn meets the legal definition of trafficking if the pornographer recruits, entices, or obtains women for the purpose of photographing live, commercial sex acts
- Some women are coerced into porn by deception, threats and violence
- Pornographers are specialized pimps who use porn to advertise prostitution and traffic women.
- One poll shows that 9% viewed porn by the age of 8, 24% by age 10, 27% by age 13. 85% were males and porn was free
- Porn industry advocates de-link porn, prostitution and trafficking to increase profits
- Disconnecting these three things normalizes the sex industry
